Social or Emotional: how your child relates with others

Adaptive Skills: how your child performs daily tasks like eating and dressing

The first 5 years of a child's life are the most important to their development. The earlier a child receives services, the more likely it is that their needs will be reduced or even eliminated as they get older. Early Stages can recommend services for children who need them.
